File: Chromebook Release

Each student in grades K-12 is automatically opted into the Mobile Device Initiative and will receive a Chromebook. Devices will be issued and assigned to students in grades K-5 and will be available to go home at the end of the day. Students in grades 6-12 will be in a one-to-one take home environment where the device should go to school and back home with the student.

It is the District's recommendation that no student be restricted access to any learning resource granted to all other students. If circumstances outside of school call for a student to have limited or restricted access to the Chromebook, a written request by the student's parent/guardian, in collaboration with a school administrator, must be placed on file with the school. If the request is initiated by a parent/guardian, approved by a school administrator and placed on file with the technology office, a student may be granted "as needed only" access to their device, rather than having it issued permanently into the student's possession. "As needed" devices will be assigned to the student and available for daily check in and check out. More information is available in the [Mobile Device Handbook](#).

As a parent or guardian I understand that by default, I opt in for my student to receive a Chromebook and will be responsible for the \$10 device protection plan per child. The cost for families with four or more students will be capped at \$30. Failure to do so will result in the device not being enrolled in the device protection plan and all costs for repair/replacement will be at the user's expense. Benefits of the device protection plan include:*

1. 1st and 2nd claim: Free (unless full replacement is required)
2. 3rd claim and beyond: Total cost of repair and/or replacement.
3. Lost/stolen/destroyed device: \$75
